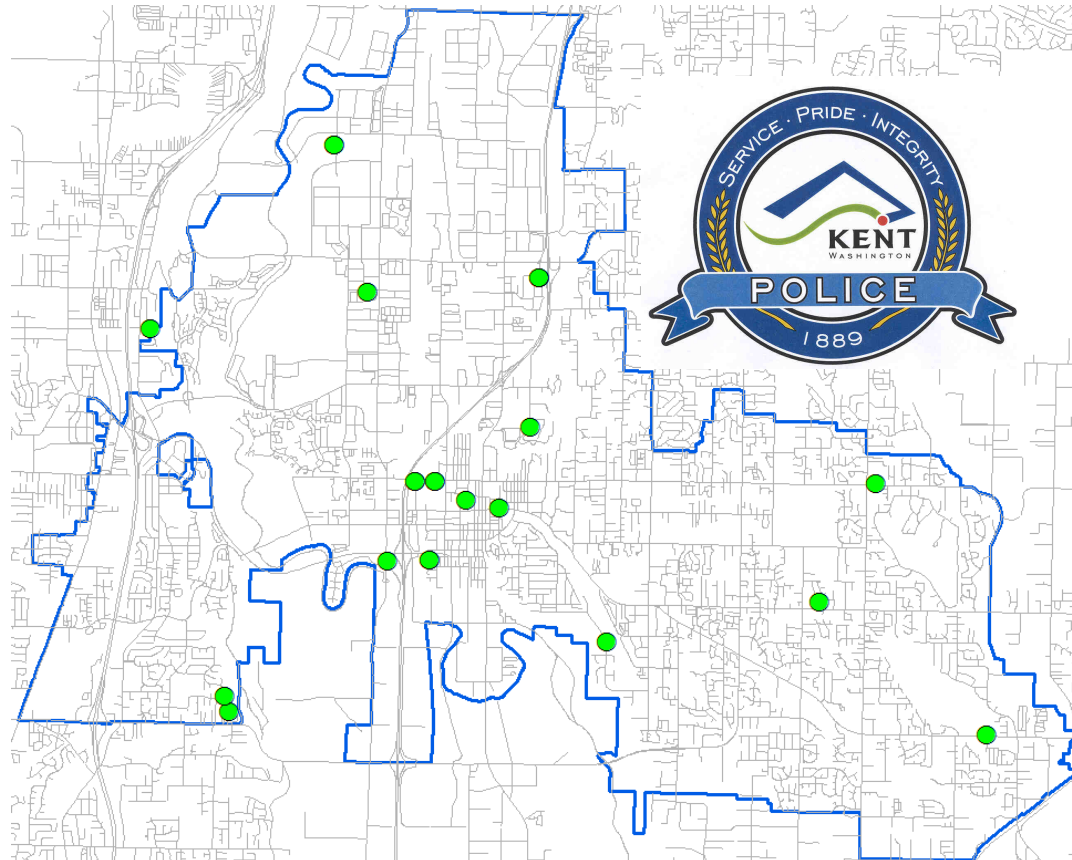

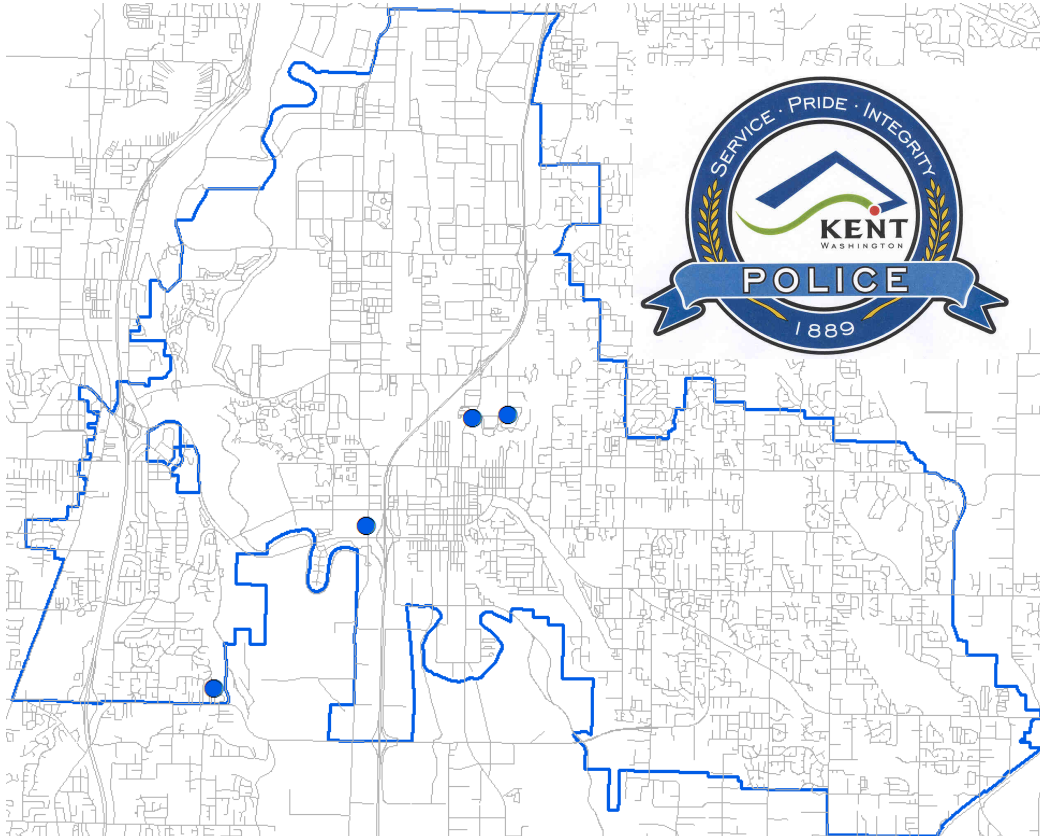

Lock Up Your License Plate
 There has been an increase in license plate thefts. There are a few things you can do to make it harder for a criminal to access yours:

- Use four screws to attach your plate. Most plates are secured using only two. Make sure you secure the front and back license plates.
- Use "anti-theft" screws that can be purchased at a hardware store and relatively inexpensive (\$3-\$10 for a set).
- Know your license plate number and glance at it every time you go to your car ensuring YOUR license plate is there.
- If you notice tampering or if your license plate is taken, call 911 and report all you can about the incident.

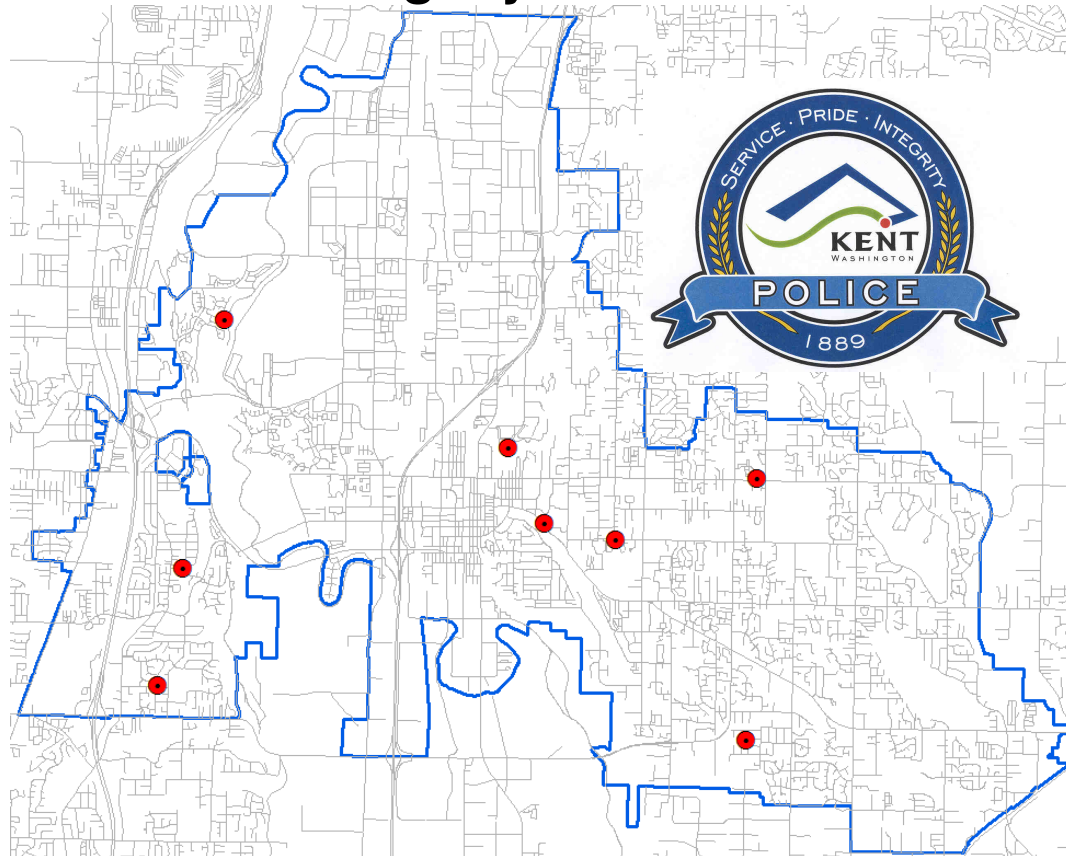

- Auto Theft Prevention - Top 10 List**
1. Remove all valuables every time you park.
 2. Lock all doors.
 3. Completely close all windows.
 4. Install and use an alarm system.
 5. Never leave your vehicle running unattended.
 6. Use a CLUB or other Steering Wheel Locking Device.
 7. Park in well-lit locations.
 8. Avoid parking in isolated areas.
 9. Remove your GPS system, including the suction cups.
 10. Call 911 at the sign of any suspicious activity.

Residential Burglary Locations Tue 9/15 – Mon 9/21



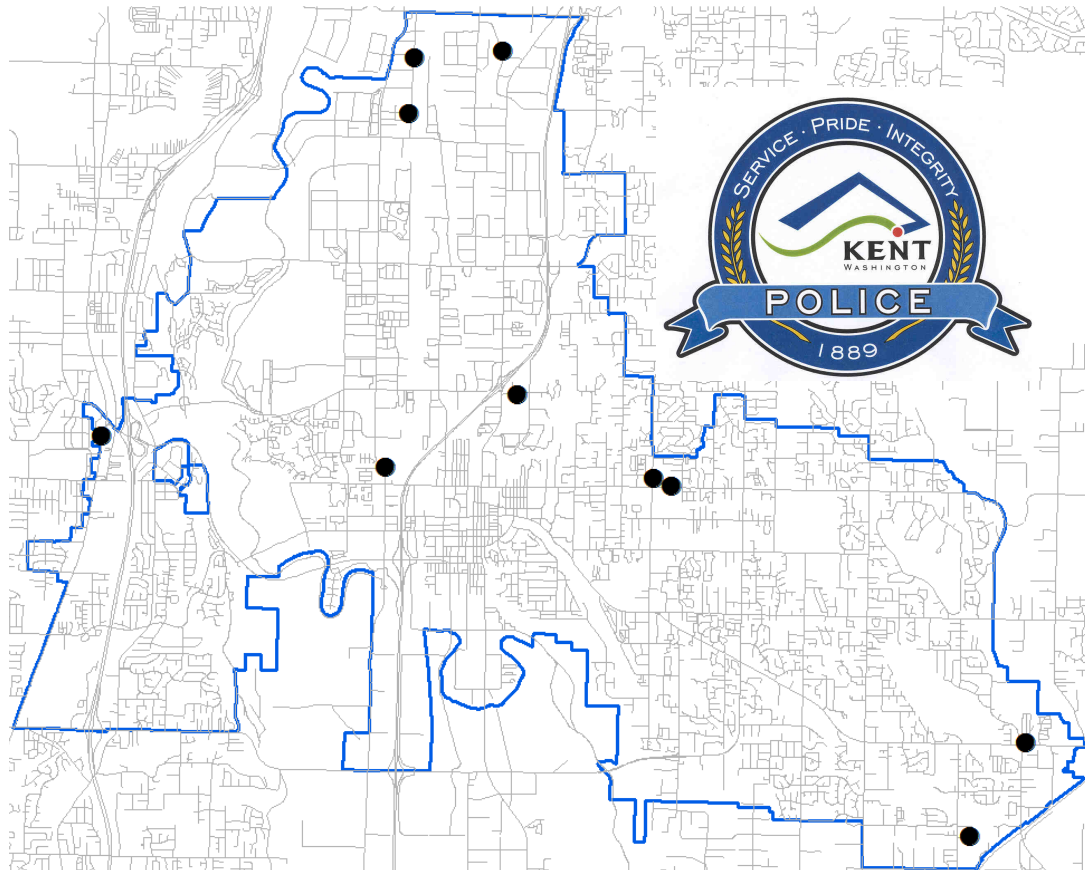

Use Storage Facilities?

If you do, you should take the following precautions to safe guard your property:

- Use "disk locks" on the exterior door of your storage unit. They are almost impossible to break, come with keys that cannot be duplicated, and are weatherproof.
- Secure all access to your unit at all times. Consider installing latch guards on the door frames.
- Inventory your belongings. Do you know what is in your unit? If not, do an inventory today and confirm it every time you visit your unit.
- Communicate with management. Express any concerns you may have about the property.
- Be Aware. Know your surroundings and make note of suspicious behavior, people, and vehicles. Call 911 and inform management too.

Crime Proof Your Business
