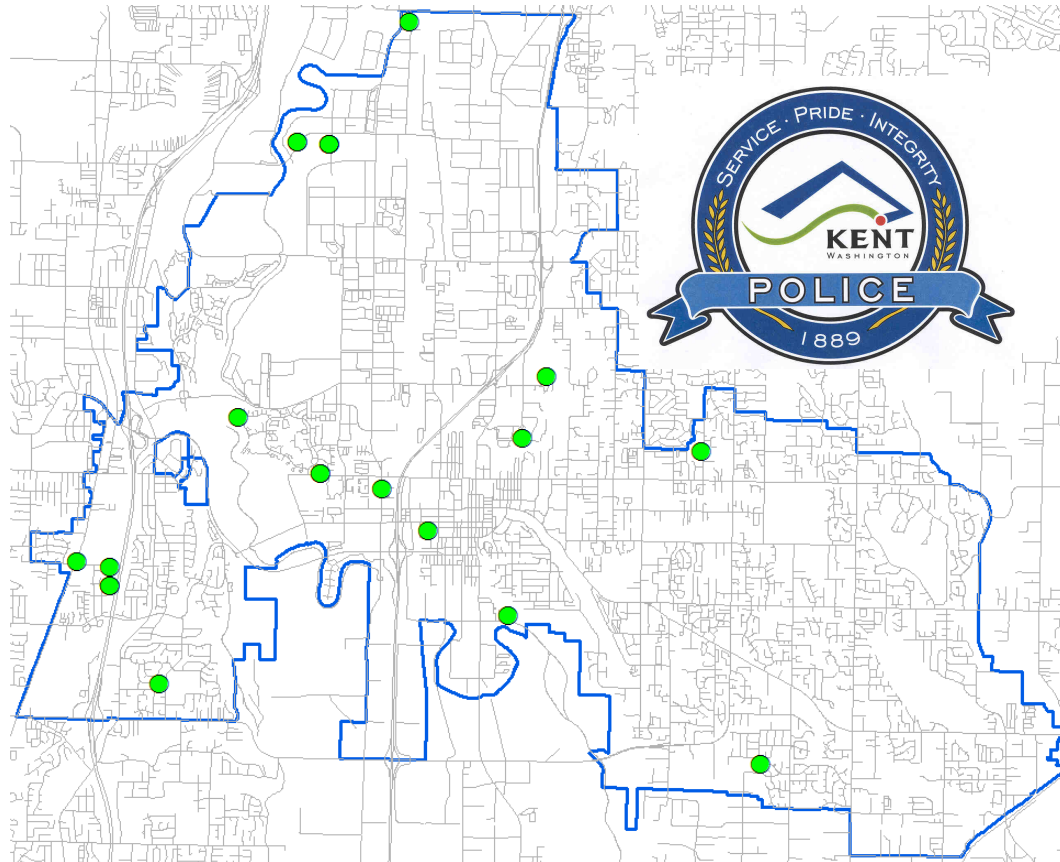

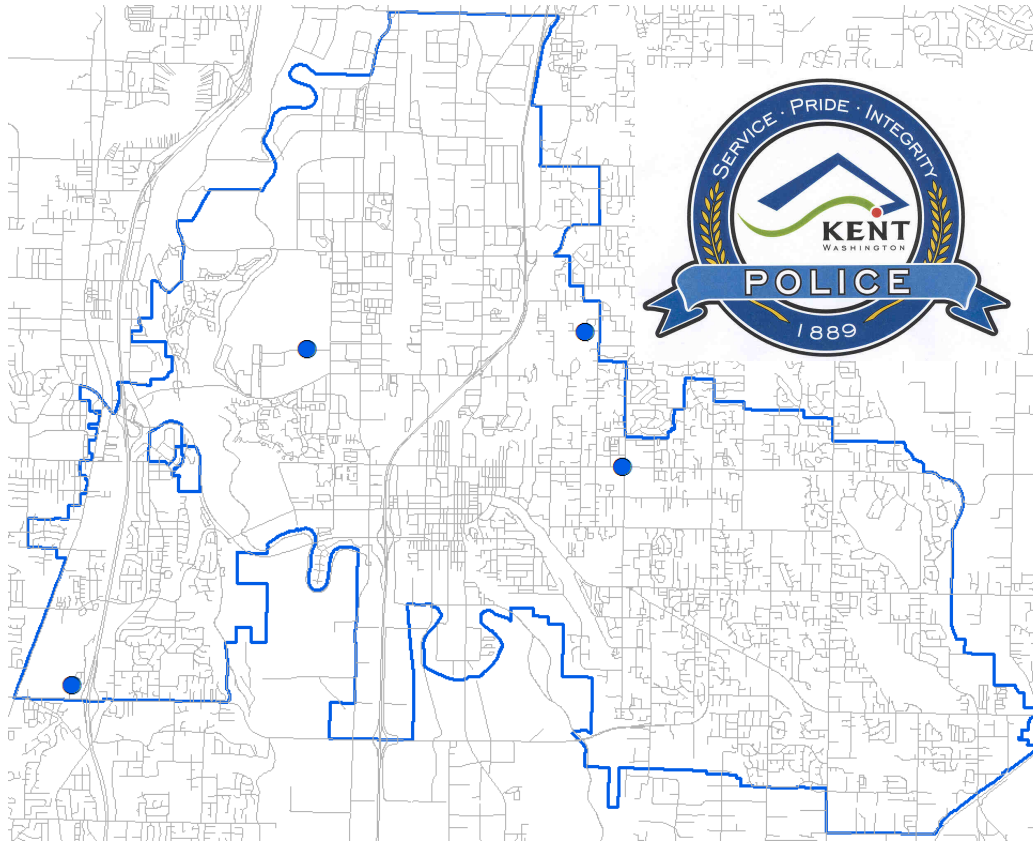

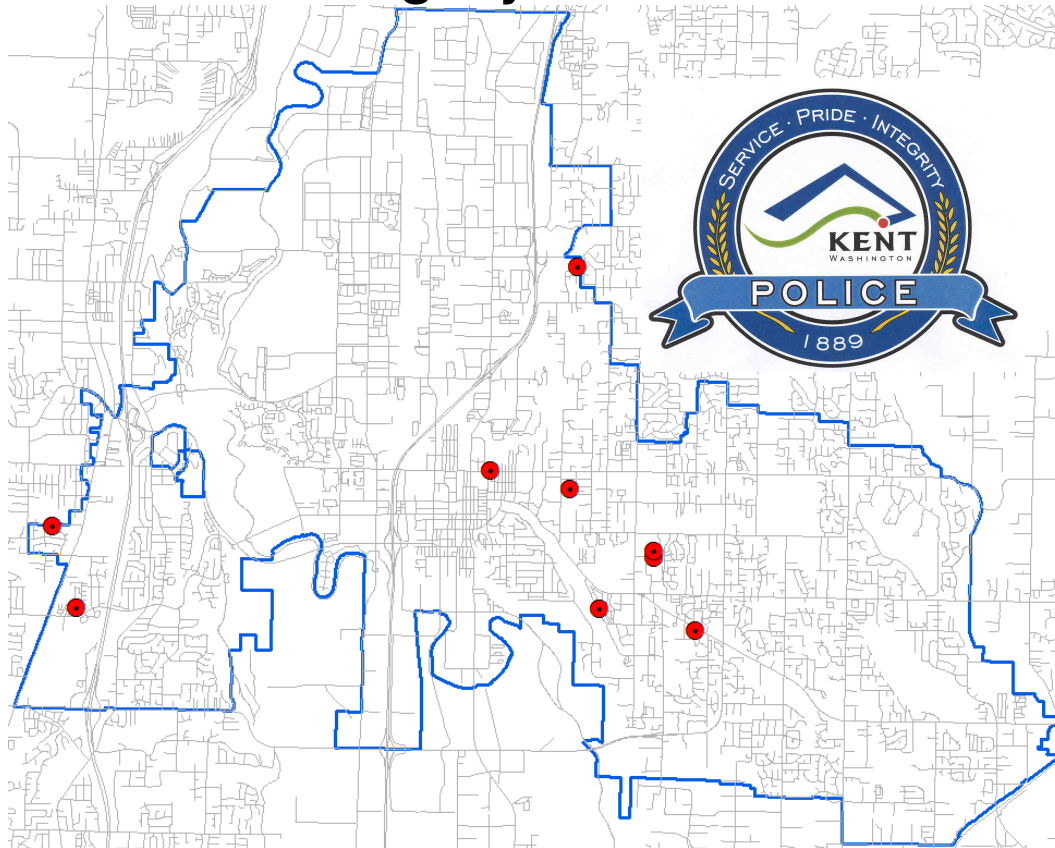

Driving Safely on Halloween

- * Be especially alert in residential neighborhoods
- * Drive more slowly and anticipate heavy pedestrian traffic on and near the road
- * Be sure to drive with your full headlights on so you can spot children from greater distances
- * Take extra time to actively look for kids at intersections, on medians and on curbs
- * Remember that costumes can limit children's visibility and they may not be able to see your vehicle
- * Enter and exit driveways and alleys slowly and carefully
- * Remember that children are excited on this night and may move in unpredictable ways
- * Remember that popular trick-or-treating hours are during the typical rush-hour period, between 5:30-9:30pm
- * Reduce any distractions inside your car so you can concentrate on the road and pedestrians

Residential Burglary Locations Tue 10/20 – Mon 10/26



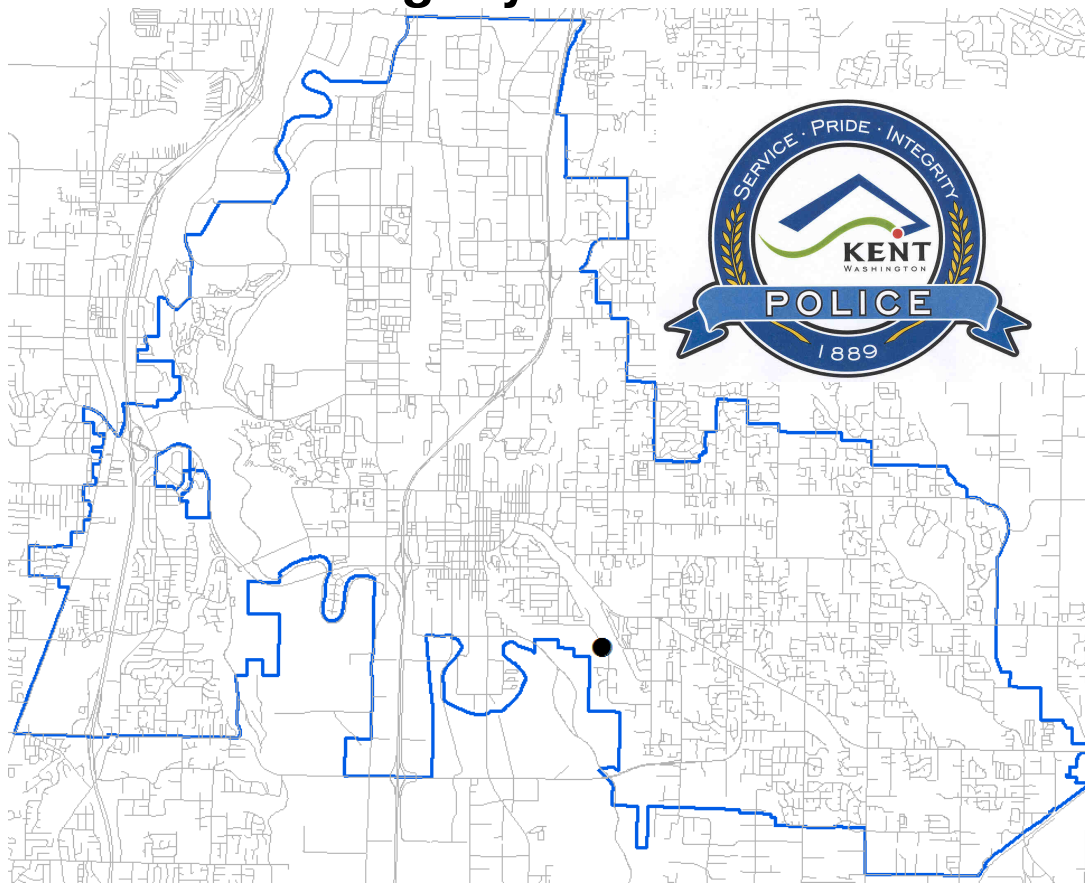

Shopping Online

Be wary of holiday crime

- Secure your computer by updating your security software
- Keep your personal information private and your password secure; do NOT respond to requests to “verify” your information
- Beware of bargains from unfamiliar companies
- Use secure websites for purchases; look for an icon of a locked padlock or “https” in the URL address; these indicate a secure website
- Investigate charities before making a donation
- Consider using onetime or multiuse disposable credit cards or money orders

Things Kids Need to Know about 9-1-1

- Know what 9-1-1 is; the number to call from any phone when help is needed right away.
- Know when to call 9-1-1; only when someone or something is in danger
- Know what happens when you call 9-1-1; the person on the phone wants to help you and will ask questions
- Never hang up; stay on the phone until the call taker tells you to hang up
- Memorize important information; children should know their address, parents complete names, and phone numbers.
- Know where you are; if you're not at home, look for a street sign or a building with a name
- Try not to be scared; when you call 9-1-1 you become the eyes and ears for the call taker
